

Betimo Fodder Beet.

Description

Betimo fodder beet is a newly bred variety, recently released for the first time in New Zealand in 2016. Betimo is a medium dry matter content, mono-germ fodder beet with large red tankard shaped bulbs. It has improved disease tolerance giving more clean, green leaf. It has good bolting tolerance and can be grazed in-situ, or be lifted and fed whole or chopped.

- Strong foliar growth producing large tops makes Betimo suitable for grazing in-situ
- Suitable for sheep, cattle and deer
