

# “La Paloma” Bermuda Grass

*Bermuda grass seed is a widely adapted warm season grass that is used for lawns, sports fields, golf courses, pastures, roads, and erosion control among other uses.*

## Characteristics & Advantages:

LaPaloma bermuda grass seed has proven to be a perfect choice for high end grass projects as it exhibits finer leaf texture than most seeded Bermuda grass varieties available.

In certain trials, it is comparable for overall turf quality to Yukon, Princess, and Riviera. La Paloma has improved cold tolerance, and shade from trees.

La Paloma exhibits short plant height – a distinguishing characteristic among available seed propagated varieties. It is noted for good stolon length, for rapid cover and filling on planting sites – important for earlier opening and use of planted projects.

- Fine textured and dark green colour for superior turf quality
- Improved performance under humid conditions
